

Ramsac helps out at V fest

SURREY IT solutions consultancy ramsac provided network support at the V Festival 2007. For the fourth year in succession, ramsac was chosen by event promoter Metropolis Music to support the backstage network that provides internet and email access to temporary on-site offices for the production teams and performers.

The V Festival took place in August at Hylands Park in Chelmsford, Essex and Weston Park in Staffordshire and attracted more than 160,000 people each day. Each of the 102 acts billed to appear over the weekend have individual production teams that require backstage access to internet and email and Bob Angus, director of the V Festival, explained: 'It is very important that the production teams of the headline and supporting acts have internet access and as the festival promoters, we must have access to our company network to coordinate all event logistics.'

Throughout the event ramsac provided backstage network support and was available for consultancy, advice and on-site support, ensuring that any technical problems were dealt with immediately.

Technical consultant at ramsac, Paul Mew, commented: 'We had a dedicated support team on hand throughout the weekend to ensure that all technical problems were rectified as soon as possible. Some of the supporting acts only have limited time in their dressing rooms, so it is essential that they are able to access the internet and their emails instantly.'
