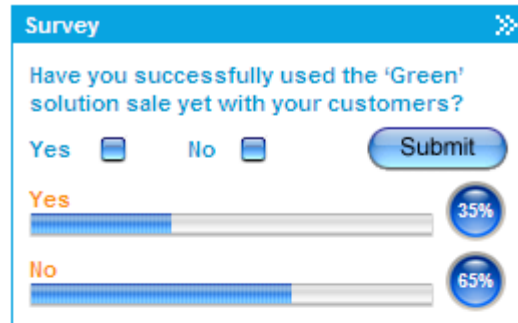


Ramsac Continues to Expand Following a Record Breaking 2007
