What is Cyber Essentials? Cyber Essentials is a Government-backed and industry supported scheme to guide businesses in protecting themselves against common cyber threats.

of all sizes and in all sectors. It is vital all organisations focus on basic cyber hygiene, to ensure they are better protected from the most common cyber threats. The Cyber Essentials Scheme has been developed as part of the UK's National Cyber Security Programme and in close consultation with industry.

Improves your GDPR position

The assessment for Cyber Essentials, will lead to improved controls which will reduce the impact of attacks or breaches and improve GDPR compliance.
